## Umpiring Subsidies



1st January 2015

1. **Aim:**

- 1.1 The aim of this policy is to ensure that Waratah Netball Club encourages umpires to gain suitable qualifications for their role in the Club.

2. **Background**

- 2.1 Waratah Netball Club also recognises that National coaching qualifications can impose a significant financial burden on those members seeking to conduct formal training. Waratah Netball Club therefore agrees that the Club should subsidise coaches toward suitable qualification. This is in line with the Club policy of as many coaches as possible achieving the minimum of Foundation Course qualification.

- 2.2 However, it was also noted that the Club will also require some form of commitment from the recipients of the subsidy, and the Committee agreed that the best way to do this was to require the umpire to share some of the costs of their training.

3. **Policy**

- 3.1 The Club will subsidise umpires up to a total value of \$100 per year. This will be in the form of a 50% subsidy for umpiring training, in particular costs associated with fees for courses. The subsidy will also be available for the costs of seminars and other training events.

- 3.2 In order to receive the subsidy, the umpies must have achieved, or be in the process of achieving, a recognised course (eg Level 1).

4. **With Effect Date.** This policy is in effect 1<sup>st</sup> January 2015.
